

Current RSVP Volunteer Opportunities for Silverton & Mt. Angel Community.



You've gained a lifetime of experience, now is the time to put your skills and talents to good use by volunteering through RSVP at any of these Silverton or Mt. Angel area sites:

1. **Silverton Area Community Aid:** 421 S. Water St, Silverton. Volunteers needed during the week from 9am-noon to help stock shelves and assist clients; days flexible. Volunteers are also needed October-December for the Annual SACA Food Drive and the Holiday Box Food Give Away, days/times flexible. There is also a need for volunteers who are able to help clients get firewood at the City Shops and picking up bread from various stores in the area.
2. **Gordon House Conservancy:** 869 W Main (at Oregon Garden), Silverton. A fan of Frank Lloyd Wright? The Conservancy is looking for volunteers to serve as tour guides, help with the house's native garden, cataloguing records, assisting with the museum library, or helping with a variety of special events throughout the year. Days/hours are flexible.
3. **Community Roots School:** 330 N James St., Silverton. Opportunities to volunteer with their gardening program, a reader with students, as a recess supervisor, assisting with PE, and an assistant with Spanish class. Days and hours are flexible, with opportunities Monday-Friday between 9am-3pm.
4. **Meals on Wheels:** Drivers for Meals-on-Wheels are needed Monday-Friday, assistance also needed in preparing and packing the meals, 9am-12pm.
5. **Providence Benedictine Center:** 540 S Main, Mt. Angel. Opportunities to assist residents to and from music programs and assist residents with Bingo games. Volunteers needed Monday, Tuesday, Thursday or Friday between the general hours of 1pm-4:30pm.
6. **ASAP Afterschool Program:** 303 N Church St, Silverton. Volunteers needed as homework tutors, enrichment activity leaders, or helping to pick-up and prepare snacks for the afterschool participants. Program serves youth in grades 7 & 8, Tuesdays and Thursdays between 3pm-6pm.
