



Volunteer Position Description

Seasonal Landscaping Projects

The City of Woodburn is seeking active high school students to assist with Seasonal Landscaping Projects. By assisting with the maintenance duties for the City you help ensure the quality and sustainability of grounds maintenance services by minimizing costs and creating a safe and beautiful environment for the community!

Duties: Must attend City volunteer orientation. Spruce up landscaping by removing debris and trash, planting new plants on the ground and/or pots and spread barkdust in specific areas.

Qualifications: All volunteers must complete a City of Woodburn Volunteer Application, background check (18yrs+), and orientation. Student must be in good health and able to lift, bend, kneel, and stand for extended periods of time. All plants and equipment will be provided.

Time Commitment: One day projects, 2-6 hours depending on number of volunteers and work pace.

Compensation:

Students will gain valuable real life experience working for a government organization that they will be able to use on college and job applications. Hours spent at working for the City of Woodburn may also be used for Senior Projects and/or volunteer hours. Students who perform well may obtain a letter of recommendation or a reference from City staff.
