

Current RSVP Volunteer Opportunities for the Salem & Keizer Communities.



You've gained a lifetime of experience, now is the time to put your skills and talents to good use by volunteering through RSVP at any of these Salem or Keizer area sites:

1. **Marion-Polk Food Share:** 1660 Salem Industrial Dr NE, Salem. Volunteers needed during the week to help at the food bank with re-packing food items, stocking shelves, and more. Volunteers are also needed to assist at area community gardens, and with MPFS fundraising events. Days/hours are flexible.
2. **Salem-Keizer Community Development Corporation:** 945 Columbia St NE, Salem. Want to help people make dollars & cents of it? Volunteer as a Financial Literacy Instructor, just a 6-8 hour commitment per month and instructor training provided for you! SKCDC is also in need of volunteers to assist with their fundraising events and to serve as Tax Site Coordinators each year from January-April.
3. **SMART Reader at Yoshikai Elementary:** 4900 Jade St. NE, Salem. Be a SMART Reader and help improve the reading level of a K-2nd grade student. Research shows that students need to be reading at grade level by 3rd grade in order to be successful as they progress through middle and high school. An hour commitment once a week will serve two students in this highly effective program. Recruitment is underway for the 2013-14 school year!
4. **The Salvation Army:** 1977 Front St NE, Salem. Have a green thumb? Teach the housing residents at The Salvation Army how to get the most from their community garden. Time ideally would be in the early evening, but could be flexible based on volunteers availability. Volunteers are also needed to pack food boxes at their on-site pantry; Tues, Wed, Thur or Friday with shifts from 9am-11am or 1pm-2:30pm.
5. **Keizer/Salem Senior Center:** 930 Plymouth Dr NE, Keizer. Wide variety of opportunities on-site at the Center for **non-RSVP** community volunteers including helping with their Monday morning breakfasts, manning the reception desk, leading a class or activity, and much more! Days/hours are flexible.
