



Volunteer Position Description

Youth Sport Referee (Basketball and Soccer)

The City of Woodburn is seeking active high school students to referee youth soccer and basketball programs. The Parks and Recreation Department is proud to promote healthy, active communities by providing quality recreational programming to Woodburn's youth.

Duties: Work with the Recreational Services Manager to receive schedule of events. Assist in set up and clean up of equipment and facility for assigned sport(s). Be knowledgeable of all officiating rules and playing guidelines for their assigned sport(s). Attend scheduled staff meetings and training.

Make fair and consistent calls. Be respectful and professional to participants and fellow staff. Pay attention to game at all times. Inform scorekeepers of points scored and fouls incurred throughout the game. Always come properly equipped – whistle, shoes, flags, etc. Control on field/court situations early.

Qualifications: All volunteers must complete a City of Woodburn Volunteer Application and orientation. Leaders must be friendly, outgoing, active, and dependable. Basic knowledge of soccer/basketball. Physical requirements include running, walking, and standing for extended periods of time. Spanish language is useful.

Time Commitment: Flexible hours available depending on student schedule.

- Basketball: January – March
- Soccer: September – November

Compensation:

Students will gain valuable real life experience working for a government organization that they will be able to use on college and job applications. Hours spent at working for the City of Woodburn may also be used for Senior Projects and/or volunteer hours. Students who perform well may obtain a letter of recommendation or a reference from City staff.
