Mayor Figley opened the workshop at 7:05 p.m. to discuss Medical Marijuana Dispensaries regulation and a proposed ordinance. City Attorney Shields provided a staff report. Council members asked questions and provided comments and direction periodically throughout the workshop. Frank Comer of Woodburn stated that he is concerned with edibles and would like to see the City constrain the use or sale of edibles if possible. Bruce of Woodburn, asked where dispensaries get there marijuana and Police Chief Russell answered that they get it from an Oregon Medical Marijuana Program grower. Mayor Figley thanked staff for their presentation and closed the workshop at 8:32 p.m.
