





RE: Smith Creek Planned Unit Development (PUD; Tax Lot 052W130000110) Subdivision Final Plat application to City (FSUB 22-01): Approval of Bond for Street Trees along Lots & a Private Common Area Tract Playground (Tract BC)

Dear Mr. AnDyke:

This is the bond approval letter for a construction performance bond for Smith Creek Planned Unit Development (PUD) Phase 4A / (plat "Smith Creek P.U.D. No. 8") street trees and a private common area tract playground, the enclosed marked landscape plan Sheet 4 illustrating the playground.





Approved landscape plans Sheet 4 excerpt – Tract BC – Private playground

Enclosure 8 is the bond titled "Subdivision Performance Bond" and is Hartford Fire Insurance Co. Bond No. 72BSBJE0661 that the developer, Lennar Northwest, LLC of Oregon dated March 5, 2024 and submitted to the City on May 17, 2024. The amount is \$85,076.91 based on Enclosure 4, the applicant's cost estimate for the street trees.

Enclosure 9 is the bond titled "Subdivision Performance Bond" and is Hartford Fire Insurance Co. Bond No. 72BSBJE0660 that the developer, Lennar Northwest, LLC of Oregon dated March 5, 2024 and submitted to the City on March 8, 2024. The amount is \$202,902.51 based on Enclosure 9, the applicant's cost estimate for the playground.

The developer requested bonding to address land use final order Condition G2 by first recording final plat and second constructing, installing, or planting the private common area tracts improvements to be bonded. The Community Development Director authorized accepting a bond request for review and staff approving the requested bond for street trees and the common area Tract BC playground improvements.

Bond approval is administrative and discretionary. Below are bond conditions of approval:

Condition B1: The bonded improvements are due by whichever occurs first:

- a. The date of first request to the City for a final inspection related to any dwelling building permit within Phase 4A / plat Smith Creek P.U.D. No. 8; or
- b. The arrival of November 14, 2025, based on land use final order Condition SUB-1, Table SUB-1 "Platting Schedule", pages 51 & 52.

Condition B2: The developer shall not obtain a certificate of occupancy (C of O) for any dwelling within Phase 4A / plat Smith Creek P.U.D. No. 8 until having met Condition B1.

Regarding inspection requests and for planning and zoning inspection in particular, Planning Division staff reminds the developer of final decision Note to the Applicant 9:

"Inspection: The applicant shall construct, install, or plant all improvements, including landscaping, prior to City staff verification. Contact Planning Division staff at least three (3) City business days prior to a desired date of planning and zoning inspection of site improvements. This is required and separate from and in addition to the usual building code and fire and life safety inspections. Note that Planning staff are not primarily inspectors, do not have the nearly immediate availability of building inspectors, and are not bound by any building inspector's schedule or general contractor convenience."

With this bond approval (and other outstanding items to be met), the Community Development Director would be ready to sign the plat Mylar, which would allow the developer to record the plat with Marion County within 30 days per Woodburn Development Ordinance (WDO) 5.01.06C.1, upon City Engineer assent to the Director signing.



Hi Colin,

Item A: Due to supply chain delays that are out of the control of our supplier the lead time for park playground equipment was significant. These items have been paid for and ordered but the delivery and installation of the material is not possible until April. The intent of this request is to mitigate the lag in time from Mylar signing to building permit issuance, so the site does not sit vacant for 3-4 months like the previous phase 3A. The play structures are projected to be completely installed before the start of building our first home in this phase.

Item B1: As required on the previous phase 3A, the intent of this request is to defer the installation of the street trees on our home frontages to the time of home construction. The purpose of this is to eliminate the damage/replacement of trees that would be caused during home building.

Item B2: Included is an updated Landscape invoice with irrigation included (link below). The new subtotal is \$56,717.94 @ 150% = \$85,076.91 please confirm this amount is acceptable for the street tree bonding amount.



STREET TREE NOTES:

1. No plant pit shall be day or approved until all underground utilities have been marked.

2. Street trees shall be healthy and vigorous with normal, well-developed branches and root systems, free from decay, defects, sunscald hip/ries and derasion of the bank, insect peets and all systems, free from decay, defects, sunscald hip/ries and derasion of the bank, insect peets and all systems, weak and interfering (rubbing) branches shall be properly removed after the tree has been planted.

4. Street trees shall not be planted a minimum of ten feet from street lights, utility poles and fire

4. Street trees shall not be planted a minimum of ten feet from street lights, utility poles and fire hydronts; five feet from water meters, driveway on delectrical/feehpone-cobel boxes; and thirty feet from street intersections where possible.
5. Trees planted within vision clearonce areas shall have all branches pruned to a height of 7' obove grade.
5. Trees the borrier shall be installed for all new street trees according to Street Tree Planting Detail.
7. Donn shall be planted in all street planting areas by adjacent property owner.
8. Street tree substitutions shall be approved by the Landscape Archifect.

NOTE: Provide temporary irrigation during construction and install permanent irrigation per Public Works Department Engineering Division standard and drawings or as the City Engineer directs, (503) 982–5248


