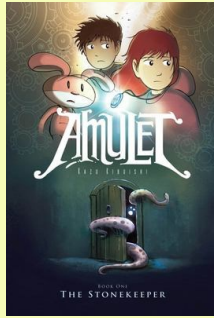


Amulet: The Stonekeeper,

by Kelly Barnhill

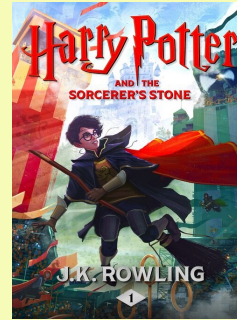

Artemis Fowl

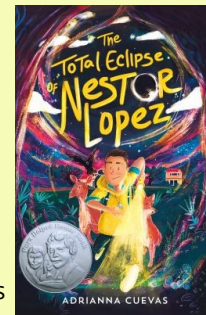
by Eoin Colfer

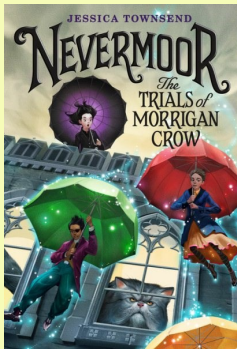
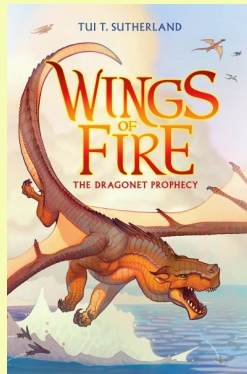

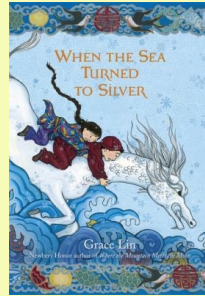


Nevermoor: The Trials of Morrigan Crow by Jessica Townsend

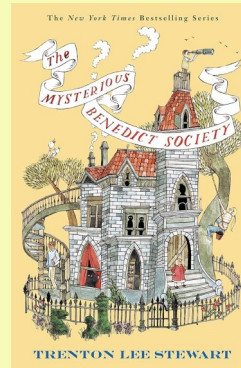
When the Sea Turned to Silver by Grace Lin



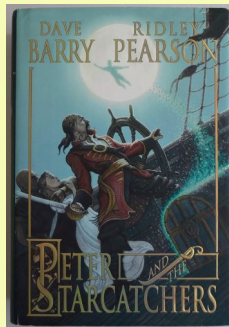

Skandar and the Unicorn Thief by A. F. Steadman

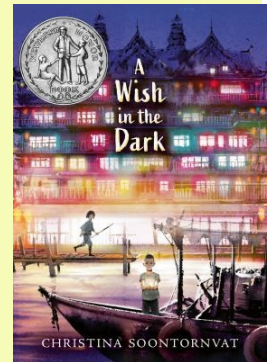
